

# PostMaster Express v7.xx Setup Guide - Linux



## How Do I Carry Out A Fresh Setup For PMXv7

The complete setup of PMXv7 covers the following steps

- Install PMXv7
- Install JRE1.6
- Start PMXv7

Please carry out all the activities below, logged in as the user you will normally login and start PostMaster. This will ensure that the file permissions required are properly maintained and will not have to be changed in future.

Also if AntiVirus for PME Mail is to be used on linux, "libstdc++-libc6.2-2.so.3" needs to be installed. "ibstdc++-libc6.2-2.so.3", is part of the package "libstdc++". This package is generally available on the Linux OS CD

### Install PMEv7

- 1. From the CD access the PMXv7 tar.gz file (PMEv7-Setup.tar.gz).
- Unzip this file using shell> tar -zxvf PMXv7-Setup.tar.gz
- 3. This will create a folder "qlc" which contains all the files required for PMEv7.

#### Install JRE1.6

While installing JRE1.6, it is advisable you extract the file from the same path from where you had extracted the PMEv7-Setup file.

- 1. From the CD access the JRE1.6 file (JRE1.6-Setup-Linux.tar.gz)
- Unzip the file using tar -zxvf JRE1.6-Setup-Linux.tar.gz
- 3. This will create a folder "qlc/shared/lin/jre1.6" which contains all the JAVA files required for PMEv7.
- 4. Extract and replace the license file in the "/qlc" folder.

### **Start PostMaster Express**

 From the ".../qlc/" folder, start pmx.sh sh pmx.sh
