On recumbents, shorter riders can sometimes experience a few problems when trying to find the right sized bike. For instance with the pedals brought back closer to the seat, they are also closer to the front wheel, which can cause "heel overlap" (where the action of pedalling can interfere with the front wheel). In order to facilitate shorter riders, Challenge offers several solutions to prevent this: shorter cranks, a slightly higher front fork crown and we even offer the Hurricane, Fujin and Taifun as a shorter frame option.

A few words on warranty

Challenge b.v. warrants the aluminium endurance frames and seats of the Challenge bikes to be free from defect in material and workmanship for the original owner for a period of ten (10) years from the date of purchase. The superlight frames (not in this brochure) from Challenge are excluded from this warranty.

The powder coating is warranted to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for the original owner for a period of five (5) years from the date of purchase. All other original components Challenge parts are warranted to be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of one (1) year from the original date of purchase.
