More freedom and independency in creating, maintaining and improving health system together with GOs

The central register of members at Medical Chamber of Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina

Common criteria for licencing and relicening of members

Common criteria for creating documents of cantonal medical chambers

Licence issued by cantonal medical chamber is automatically recognised everywhere in Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina (except in Herzegovina-Neretva Canton, they have independent medical chamber)

Licence issued by Medical Chamber of Republic of Srpska can be recognised by cantonal medical chamber, but not automatically, there is simple procedure

Bad financial and bad social status of medical doctors

Migration of medical doctors abroad, and potential lack of medical doctors

The more experts to discuss problems, the better results


The more information, the better chances for act proactivly

The chance of aplication of tested and in practice realized solutions


The chance to present domestic original solutions at international level
