#### Main Teaching

We are going to be looking at words that have the suffix -ation.

The suffix '-ation' can be added to verbs in order to form nouns.

Van Gogh went on to create many masterpieces ('create' is a verb). Ted's birthday cake was a wonderful creation ('creation' is a noun).



## Some spelling rules to help us for adding the 'ation' suffix

If the root word ends in ate: remove the 'ate' and add 'ation'
For example: locate loc + ation = location

If the root word has a vowel before an I at the end: double the 'II' before adding 'ation'

If the root word does not end in e or I: just add 'ation'
For example: inform — inform + ation = information




