STARTING JUNE 6

### FIRST MAJOR EXTENSION OF A METROLINK RAIL LINE IN 22 YEARS – 24 MILES OF NEW PASSENGER RAIL LINE –

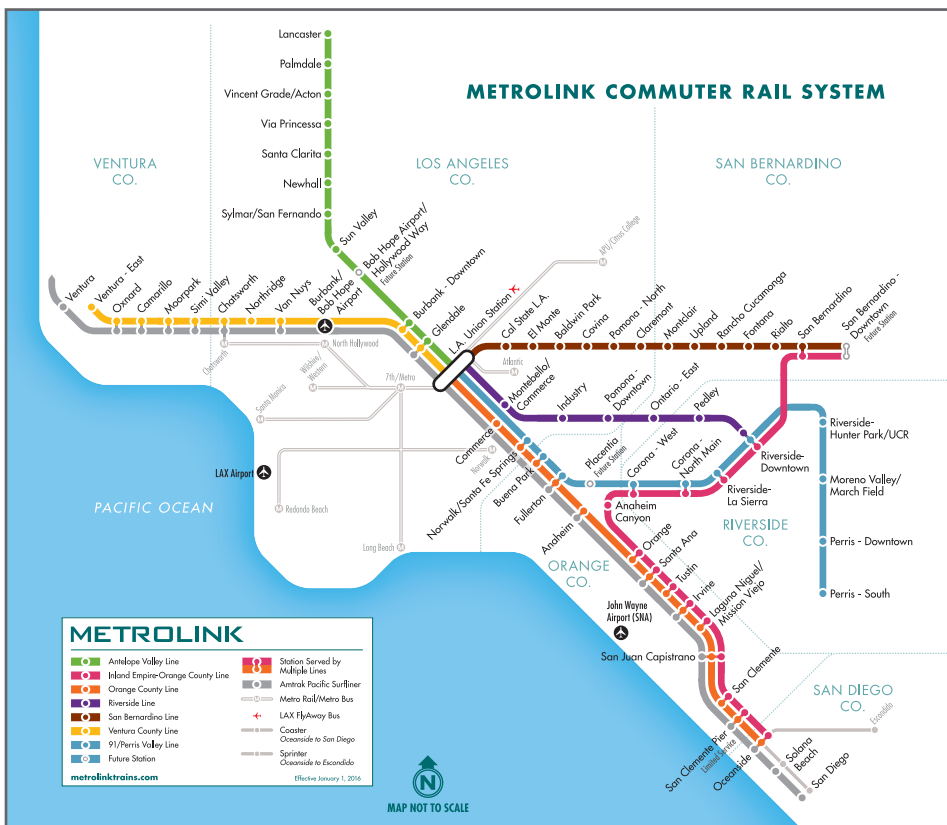
Extension plans were first approved in 2003 and construction began in 2013. Metrolink and the Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) are pleased to announce the new \$248 million 91/Perris Valley Line opens for service on June 6, 2016. This 24 miles of rail line is Metrolink's first extension since 1994.

Four new stations were added beyond the Riverside - Downtown Station: Riverside - Hunter Park/UCR Station; Moreno Valley/March Field Station; Perris - Downtown Station; and the Perris -South Station (see map below). The residents of Perris Valley can now board Metrolink at stations in their community and reach the five other counties served by Metrolink in Southern California.

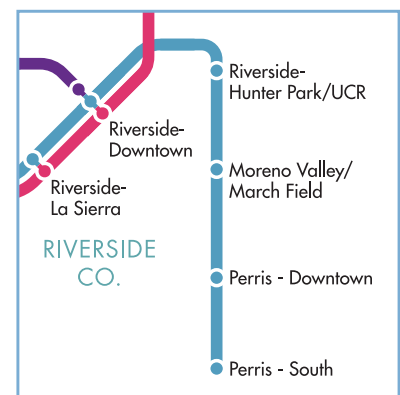
Likewise, visitors can now reach the Perris Valley by Metrolink. The 24-mile 91/PVL extension enhanced 15 at-grade railroad crossings in Riverside County and added a variety of safety measures: flashing warning devices; gates; raised center medians, striping; and pavement markings. Two pedestrian crosswalks were added at two railroad crossings and two other crossings were permanently closed for better safety.

# FOUR NEW STATIONS OPEN ON THE 91/PERRIS VALLEY LINE

**RIVERSIDE HUNTER PARK/UCR STATION**  
**1101 MARLBOROUGH AVE., RIVERSIDE, CA 92507**

This station offers convenient access from Hunter Park, UC Riverside, Highgrove and Grand Terrace. It serves numerous light industrial and manufacturing facilities and UCR College of Engineering. Parking: 417 spaces.

**MORENO VALLEY / MARCH FIELD STATION**  
**14160 MERIDIAN PARKWAY, RIVERSIDE, CA 92518**

This station serves Meridian Business Park, UC Path Center and is minutes from the March Air Reserve Base, which is being transformed into a major employment, business and logistics center. Parking: 417 spaces.

**PERRIS - DOWNTOWN STATION**  
**121 SOUTH C STREET, PERRIS, CA 92570**

This station is in the heart of downtown Perris and serves the City of Perris, Civic Center, Perris Court House and regional Perris Multimodal Center, which includes bus and Park 'n Ride facilities. Parking: 425 spaces.

**PERRIS - SOUTH STATION**  
**1304 CASE ROAD, PERRIS, CA 92570**

This station is the end point for the 91/Perris Valley Line, just north of Ethanac Road. It will serve Perris and communities to the south and east. Parking: 526 spaces.



The 91/Perris Valley Line will serve riders from Menifee, Murrieta, Temecula, San Jacinto, Hemet, Lake Elsinore and Wildomar, in addition to Perris, Moreno Valley, March Air Reserve Base and Riverside.

# RAILROAD SAFETY

## BE TRACK SMART... SIX THINGS TO KNOW:

- 1** The only safe place to cross is at a designated public crossing.
- 2** It can take more than a mile to stop a train, so it may not be able to stop in time for someone on the tracks.
- 3** Railroad property is private property. For your safety, it is illegal to be there unless you are at a designated public crossing.
- 4** Trains overhang tracks by at least 3 feet in both directions. If you are in the right-of-way next to the tracks, you can be hit by the train.
- 5** Never walk around or behind lowered gates at a crossing and do not cross the tracks until the lights have stopped flashing and it is safe to do so.
- 6** Be aware trains do not follow set schedules. Any time is train time!
