


# **Campanula IRIDESCENT BELLS**

## **FEATURES:**

- A prolific display of large, bell-shaped flowers of shiny silver overlayed with soft tints of mauve appear from spring into autumn.
- Neat, upright habit slowly spreading to form a clump.
- Easy to grow with reliable garden performance.

#### **SUGGESTED USES:**

- · Lightly shaded gardens.
- Mass plant as ornamental ground cover.
- Excellent in containers.

#### **CULTURAL CARE**

Grows well in most soil types which are moist but well draining. Can be grown in full sun when given protection from hot afternoon sun.

No pruning generally required although older foliage can be removed once new growth appears in spring to tidy appearance.

Apply a slow release fertiliser in spring. Mulch well to help retain moisture during dry periods.
