

Joseph Kisembo was born in August, 2007. His story is a tragic one. His father was Francis Tiberindwa who was 34 years old. He was married to Rose Mary Sunday for 13 years but trouble began July 19, 2012 when Francis, who is mentally ill, fatally injured his wife and subsequently took his own life. Both parents were buried on the same day. Joseph is one of four surviving orphans who are in the care of the grandfather, Vincent Byaruhanga, who is also caring for his own twelve children. The family has no source of income. In desperaation, the grandfather brought all four orphaned siblings with tears in his eyes and we gladly were accepted them. The children were traumatized by the experience, and are receiving grief counseling by a visiting social worker.

The Home of the Holy Angels is a non-profit school in Kibale, Uganda created to provide a nurturing and Christian home for children, aged preschool through age 10, in the community of Kibale, Uganda. This model residence will provide a safe home where a healthy diet, clean home and basic education will be provided by qualified, caring adults.
