Purpose:	A fluency test of word retrieval/confrontational naming.
Short description:	<p>Boston Naming Test consists of 60 black and white pictures of different objects (short version 15), ranging in linguistic difficulty. The participant`s task is to name each object in 20 seconds.</p> <p>The test material consists of a manual with pictures, administration instructions and record booklets with norms.</p>
