




Nr 1 economy in Europe, Nr 4 in the World (2011)

History of Temp Regulation

- 1967: Allowance Private Employment Agencies
- 1972: Temp Law AÜG
 - ~ Licences
 - ~ Temp Agency employees (Lohnfortzahlung)
- 2003: Changes:
 - ~ Elimination duration limitation
 - ~ Equal Pay+ or Sector CLA (Tarifvertrag)
- 2011: AÜG extension
 - ~ AÜG also for non-commercial internal agencies
- 2012: Mimimum hourly wage for temps
 - ~ As per Jan 2012: € 7,89 (west) € 7,01 (east)
 - ~ As per Nov 2012: € 8,19 (west) € 7,50 (east)










Development Temp Market Germany (AÜG)





Highly Fragmented Market


