

Alexander Grudem - Vestry Nominee

Alexander was born in Saint Paul, Minnesota. He moved to the Chicagoland area when he was two and grew up in Libertyville, IL. He graduated from Bethel College in Minnesota where he studied theatre and philosophy. He worked around the Twin Cities for a few years before he began teaching at an international high school.
