




CHRISTIAN SERVICE

Thank you to everyone for all the support over this spring; from Easter baskets to food drives, to school fundraisers, to donations for Mary's Closet – St. Petronille has been a busy place of service. I wanted to share a few updates and ask for your continued support:

- 1. **Bridge Communities** both of our families are in the process of having their quarterly reviews, where all their progress is discussed, victories are shared, and challenges are discussed. Both of our mothers continue to be beacons of hope and change for their children and inspire me on a daily basis. Thanks to our SVDP for sharing a Fish Fry dinner with our families, I know that was enjoyed by all. We also treated our families to a Barone's dinner everyone should try Barone's at least once while living in Glen Ellyn! Please continue to pray for our families, their continued forward progress, and resilience to the challenges that lay ahead.
- 2. Mary's Closet Thank you to everyone who has graciously donated goods to Mary's Closet. If you have not heard, Mary's Closet is a resource room right here at St. Petronille filled with items needed by families with children. Since Fr. Milota blessed Mary's Closet in February, we have welcomed 45 families (with a total of 79 children) to Mary's Closet. We have donated 35 packs of diapers, 65 bundles of clothing, 25 gallons of laundry detergent, and 25 sample bags of food from the Glen Ellyn Food Pantry. That's just the tip of the iceberg. We also have birthday bags, bedding, cleaning products, maternity clothes, school supplies. Families have been referred through a variety of ways, including local parish families, school, PADS, and the Renew Project students. 


