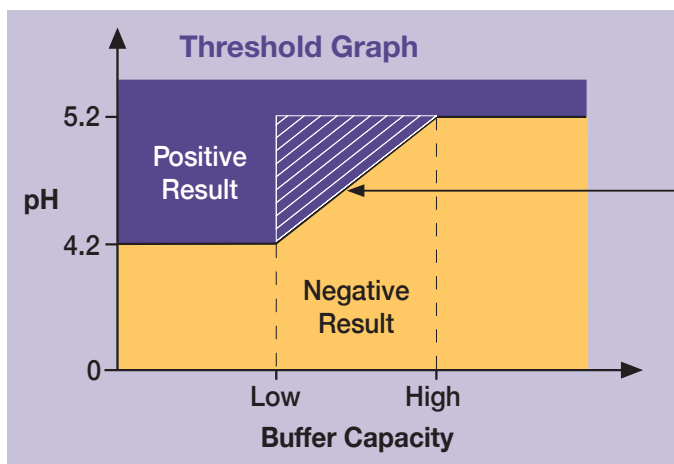

NUVETEST™ effectively measures vaginal acidity associated with BV due to its buffer capacity



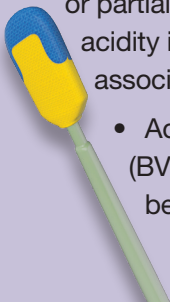
The inclusion of buffer capacity allows NUVETEST™ to capture those patients misdiagnosed with pH paper alone.

Interpretation of NUVETEST™ results

+ Positive Result

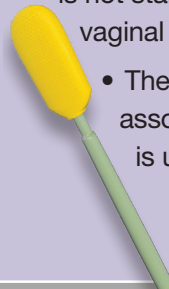
- If the tip of the NUVETEST™ swab is stained or partially stained blue or green, vaginal acidity is disordered and infections associated with high pH are quite probable.



- Additional testing for bacterial vaginosis (BV) and trichomonas should be considered.

- Negative Result

- If after **10 seconds** the NUVETEST™ tip is not stained, ie, completely yellow, vaginal acidity is normal.



- The risk of having an infection associated with elevated pH levels is unlikely.

Important: If the patient is pregnant and the tip of the NUVETEST™ swab is stained blue or green, the color change may indicate an amniotic fluid leak.

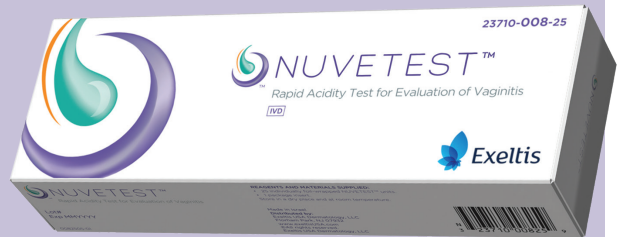

Warnings and Precautions:

- Collect vaginal discharge from the anterior fornix or lateral vaginal wall of the mid vagina. Do not insert the NUVETEST™ further than 5 cm (2") in the vagina, to avoid contact with the cervix mucus, where pH levels are known to be higher than normal vaginal pH.
- Do not use lubricants which alter vaginal acidity.
- If the patient is pregnant, the stain may indicate an amniotic fluid leakage.

To ensure valid results, do not use NUVETEST™ in any of the following conditions:

- a) Less than 1 day before or the day after the patient's menstrual period;
- b) There are signs of menstruation or any vaginal bleeding;
- c) Less than 12 hours after sexual intercourse or use of vaginal products such as douching solutions or medications which alter vaginal acidity.
