Visitors are asked to contribute a \$2 suggested donation at the entrance gates to benefit the following GEDP programs: Easton Public Market, Easton Farmers' Market, Easton Main Street Initiative, West Ward Community Initiative, Easton Garden Works, Easton Compost Program and the Easton Ambassadors. Funds raised through PA Bacon Fest support free events and programming in Easton throughout the year, including; Easton Out Loud, Live at the Falls concerts and many others.

PA Bacon Fest grew out of a special event hosted by Easton Farmers' Market — America's oldest, continuous open-air market, established in 1752.
