
UN-Habitat is mandated by the UN General Assembly to promote socially and environmentally sustainable cities and towns.

132 million people pushed into poverty over the next 10 years






70% of the population will live in cities by 2050

WORLD URBAN FORUM



Established in 2001 by the United Nations to address one of the most pressing issues facing the world today: rapid urbanization.



UN-Habitat Induction

- A **non-legislative meeting** open to diverse constituencies
- **Convened by UN-Habitat** and co-organized with a host city once in two years
- WUF11 took place in Katowice, Poland
- WUF12 will take place in Cairo, Egypt
- WUF13 bidding is open until mid-February

31 October, mandated by the UN to celebrate cities and urban environment


