



# Quecksilberverbindungen als SRIN - Rechtsgrundlage

## Artikel 3 Absatz 3 der Verordnung (EU) 2017/852 über Quecksilber

### Artikel 3

#### Ausfuhrbeschränkungen

- (1) Die Ausfuhr von Quecksilber ist verboten.
- (2) Die Ausfuhr der in Anhang I aufgeführten Quecksilberverbindungen und -gemische ist ab dem dort jeweils festgelegten Datum verboten.
- (3) Abweichend von Absatz 2 ist die Ausfuhr der in Anhang I aufgeführten Quecksilberverbindungen für die Forschung im Labormaßstab oder Laboranalysen zulässig.

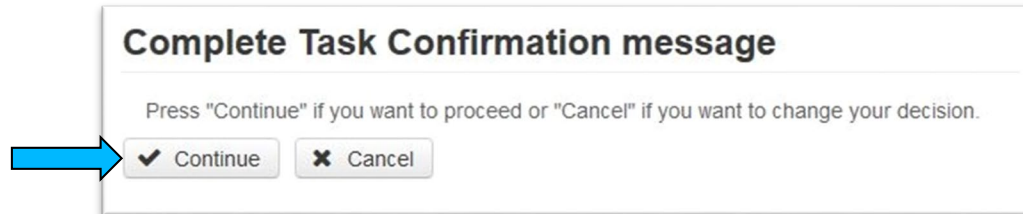



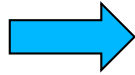

Eine Entscheidung über den Antrag gilt als in Absprache mit der Kommission getroffen, wenn es innerhalb von zehn Tagen, nachdem die bezeichnete nationale Behörde des Mitgliedstaats, der ihr Informationen über den Antrag übermittelt hat, keine abweichende Antwort seitens der Kommission gegeben hat.
