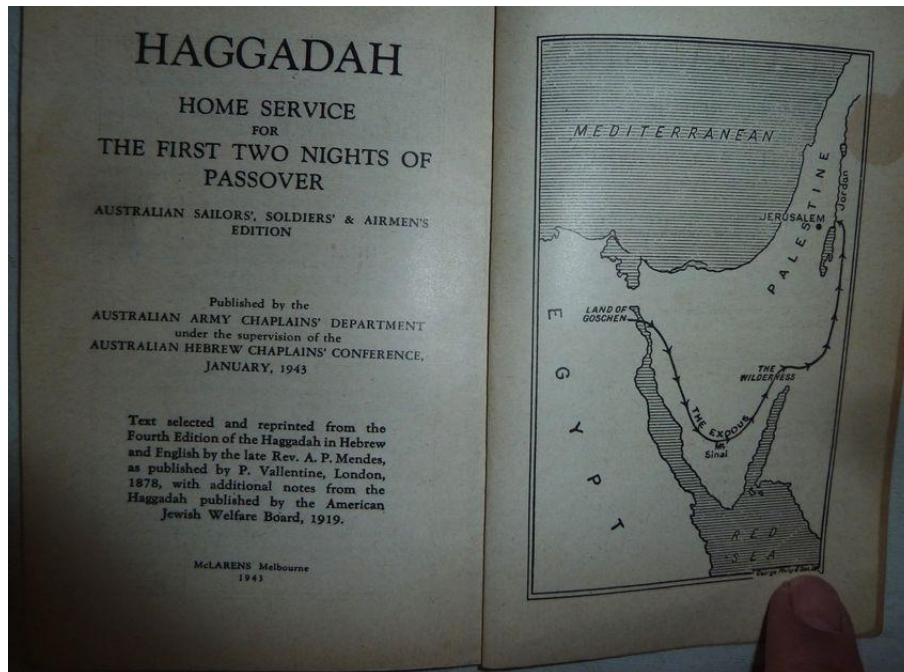

9. November 1938!

Die Erinnerung an diesen Tag läßt vor dem getragenen Auge eines jeden deutschen Menschen, der sich auch nur einen Rest von Menschlichkeit und Achtung vor menschlicher Würde bewahrt hat, eine der grauhaftesten Bilder aus der Zeit der Nazi-Diktatur aufsteigen.

Im nächtlichen Dunkel stürzte sich damals das „bis aufs tiefste emporste deutsche Volk“ auf eine aus dem Schlaf aufgeschreckte, wehrlose, vorher bereits rechtlos gemachte Minderheit des deutschen Volkes. Unter Alkohol gesetzte SS- und SA-Banden fielen in ganz Deutschland auf vorbereiteten Befehl nach einem bis ins Einzelne genau ausgearbeiteten Plan der höchsten Kommandostellen der Gestapo, SS und SA — wie das im Nürnberger Prozeß bewiesen wurde — spontan über die Juden, über arme und begüterte Juden, über Händer, ihre Geschäfte, ihre Betriebe, ihre Häuser, über Möbel und Gegenstände aller Art aus den Fenstern und die Scherben und Bruchstücke der jüdischen Haushalte bedeckten alle Straßen, das Straßengestühl, Plündernde Horden raubten und zerstörten Warenlager und Einrichtungen jüdischer Geschäfte, ohne daß die Polizei eingreift, Flammen schlagen aus den Synagogen und Bethäusern auf und beleuchten flackernd die infernalische Szene, während die Feuerwache laterale zuseht.

Zu Tausenden verlassen die Juden in dieser Schreckensnacht ihre Wohnungen. Die meisten aber bleiben, gebannt von dem grauhaften Schauspiel, erstarrt und reaktionsunfähig vor so viel menschlicher Bestialität und lassen willkürliche Raubereien, Mißhandlungen und Forderungen über sich ergehen, Zehntausende wurden anschließend in Schutzhaft genommen oder in die Konzentrationslager verschleppt. Wie konnte es geschehen, daß deutsche Menschen sich zu solchen Schandtaten hergaben? Es gab in Deutschland bereits vor 1938 einen organisierten Antisemitismus. Die breite Masse des deutschen Volkes blieb aber dem Antisemitismus gegenüber immun. Der Nationalsozialismus erst hat den Kampf gegen das Judentum auf einen Höhepunkt gebracht. Er hat den Massenkampf geprägt und beschränkt uns die „strahlende“ Lichtfigur des nordischen, arischen „Erdmenschens“, den alleinigen „Schöpfer aller wahren Kultur, aller menschlichen Fortschritte“ neben dem „minderwertigen“, negroiden, jüdischen oder verädelten „Hornmenschen“, dessen Unterdrückung und Vernichtung im Interesse der Erhaltung des deutschen Volkstums nicht nur als erforderlich, sondern auch als geboten und gerechtfertigt erklärt wurde. „Der Jude muß verbrannt werden“ — das war nicht nur ein satirisches Schlagwort, sondern die politische Zielsetzung des Nationalsozialismus. Und leider hat die nationalsozialistische Massenlehre tatsächlich breite Kreise des deutschen Volkes erfaßt. Daran ändert auch die Tatsache nichts, daß eine gewisse Zahl deutscher Menschen die Ereignisse des 9. November 1938 verurteilten.

Wer aber weiß heute noch im deutschen Volke, was diesen Greuelen des 9. November 1938 vorausging? Zur Not erinnern sich einige noch daran, daß der Anlaß die Erschließung des deutschen Gesundheitssekretärs vom Rath in Paris durch einen gewissen Grönbom war. Es handelt sich dabei nicht — wie die verlogene Hitler-Propaganda Mißverständnisse — um ein Attentat des Weltjudentums. Wer dieser Gruppen? Ein blutjunger polnischer Jude, der in Frankreich vorübergehend Asyl gefunden hatte. Was hat die Tat dieses jungen, unreifen, unangesehenen Menschen ausgelöst? Im Oktober 1938 — wenige Wochen vor dem Anlaß — war bereits schon einmal ein nächtlicher Putsch verübt worden gegen Juden durchgeführt worden. Juden polnischer Staatsangehörigkeit, seit langem in Deutschland ansässig, wurden nachts aus den Betten herausgeholt und unter Zurücklassung aller ihrer Habe nach Polen abtransportiert. Die damalige reaktionäre, antisemitische polnische Regierung — aufs engste mit Hitler verbunden — sperrte kurzer Hand die Landesgrenzen vor dem zurückkehrenden Strom jüdischer Landsleute. Eingekerkert auf einen schmalen Streifen Niemandsland bei Złoczyn, hausten nun diese Unglücklichen in primitiven Notunterkünften oder im Freien bei ungeschützter Erstrahlung. Alte und Junge, Männer, Frauen und Kinder, Kranke und Gesunde, von Freunden und Familien abgeschnitten, dem Unbill der Witterung ausgesetzt und verlassen befanden sich die Eltern des jungen Grönbom in Paris zu ihrer Rettung anzureufen. Dabei stieß er auf starke Ablehnung seitens des Gesundheitssekretärs vom Rath. Die ganze Erbitterung und Verzweiflung eines jungen Menschen, der das Bild seiner hungernden und verendenden Eltern vor Augen hatte, entlod sich in dieser Verzweiflungsthat. Der Schuß auf den Gesundheitssekretär vom Rath, der die ganze zivilisierte Welt aufhorchen ließ, hatte auch das deutsche Volk aufwachen und ihm Anlaß zur Bezeichnung und zur Abkehr werden müssen. Das Gegenteil trat ein.

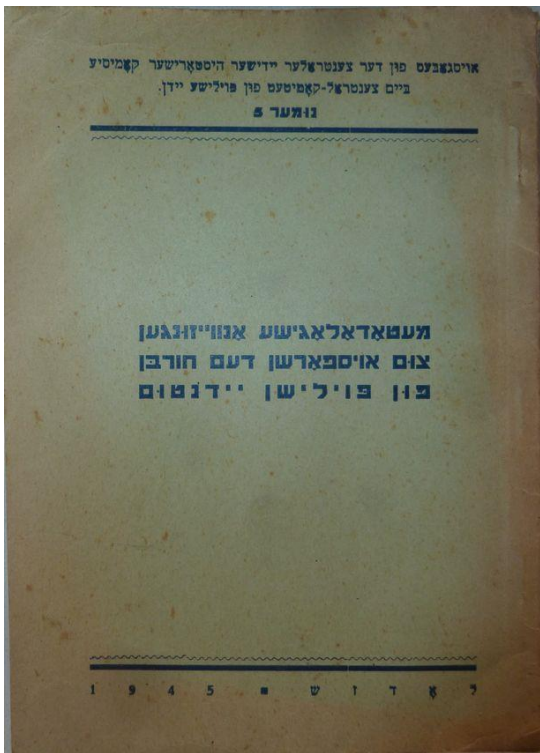

Der 9. November 1938 wurde inszeniert. Von diesem Tag ab wurde Deutschland zu einer Falle für seine jüdischen Staatsbürger. Diesem Tag der Schande für unser ganzes Volk folgte die zwangsweise Eingliederung der Juden in den Arbeitsdienst, ihre Deportation und das Grauen der Gaskammern und der Vernichtungslager.

Im Gesamtgebiet des Landes Nordrhein-Westfalen befinden sich heute nur noch wenige überlebende Juden. In der Nordrhineprovinz sind es nur noch 2000 Personen, darunter 83 Kinder unter 18 Jahren. Alle anderen Juden wurden ermordet, vergraben und vernichtet. Diese wenigen Greisheiten, die wie durch ein Wunder den Vernichtungslagern entronnen sind, unter welchen Umständen leben sie heute, 18 Monate nach dem Zusammenbruch des Nationalsozialismus? Nur wenigen unter ihnen ist es gelungen, sich eine gesunde Existenzbasis zu verschaffen, die schwere körperlichen Schädigungen, die sie erlitten haben, zu über-

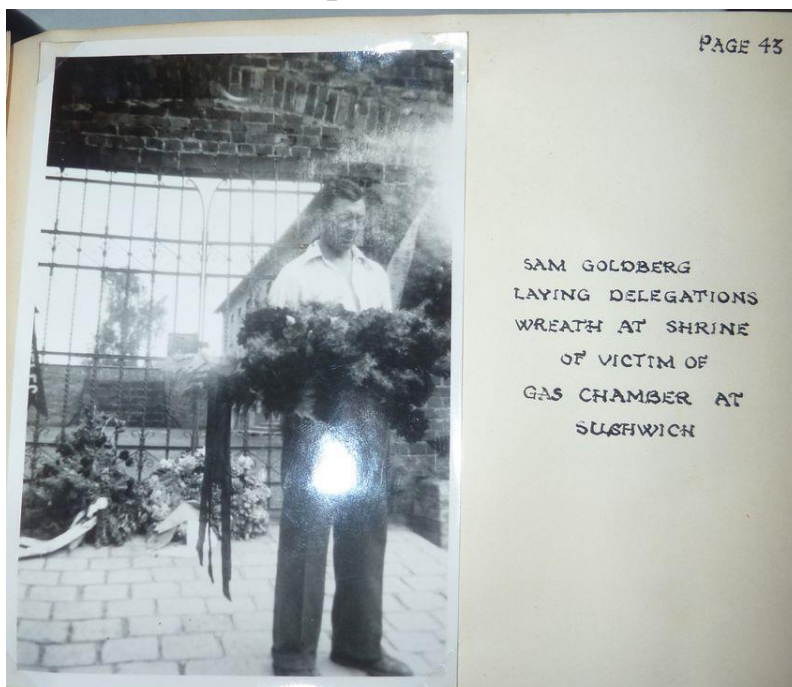

Adolf Henryk Silberschein was a Polish-Jewish lawyer, activist of the World Jewish Congress, Zionist, member of the Polish Sejm (1922–27). During the Holocaust he was a member of the Ładoś Group an informal group of Jewish organizations and Polish diplomats who forged and smuggled illegal Latin American passports to occupied Poland, saving their holders and their families from immediate deportation to German Nazi death camps.

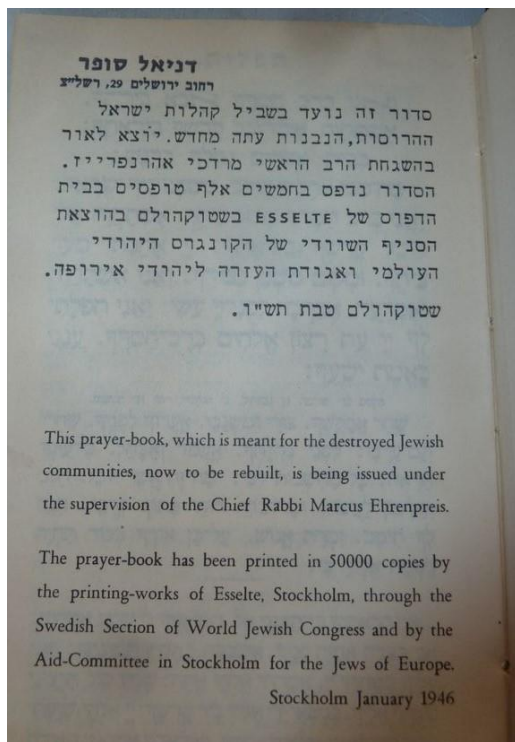

By the end of WWII there were about 30,000 Jewish refugees in Shanghai many of them saved by an extraordinary Japanese diplomat Chiune Sugihara who issued Japanese visas for many Jewish people trying to escape the Nazis. of the greatest speeches of his long
parliamentary career against this
White Paper. The White Paper
imposed severe immigration
restrictions. During the next five
years Jewish immigration would be
limited to 75,000, bringing the
Jewish population up to
approximately one-third of the total
population of Palestine.

After the end of the five-year period
no further Jewish immigration

would be permitted "unless the Arabs of Palestine are prepared to
acquiesce in it," and the government "will not be under any obligation to
facilitate the further development of the Jewish National Home by
immigration regardless of the wishes of the Arab population."

This White Paper was regarded by the Zionist movement and many
outside it as a final betrayal of Britain's obligations to the Jewish people
under the Balfour Declaration and the Mandate. The announcement of
this policy at the outset of the Jewish mass flight from Europe became
the starting point for the active struggle of the Yishuv against the

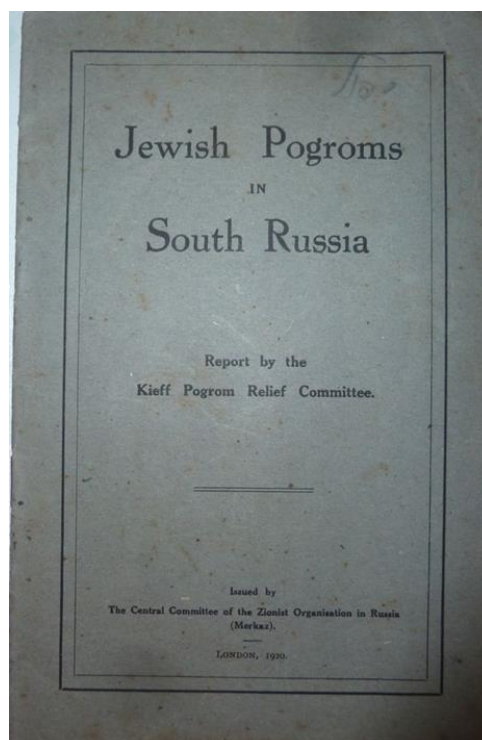

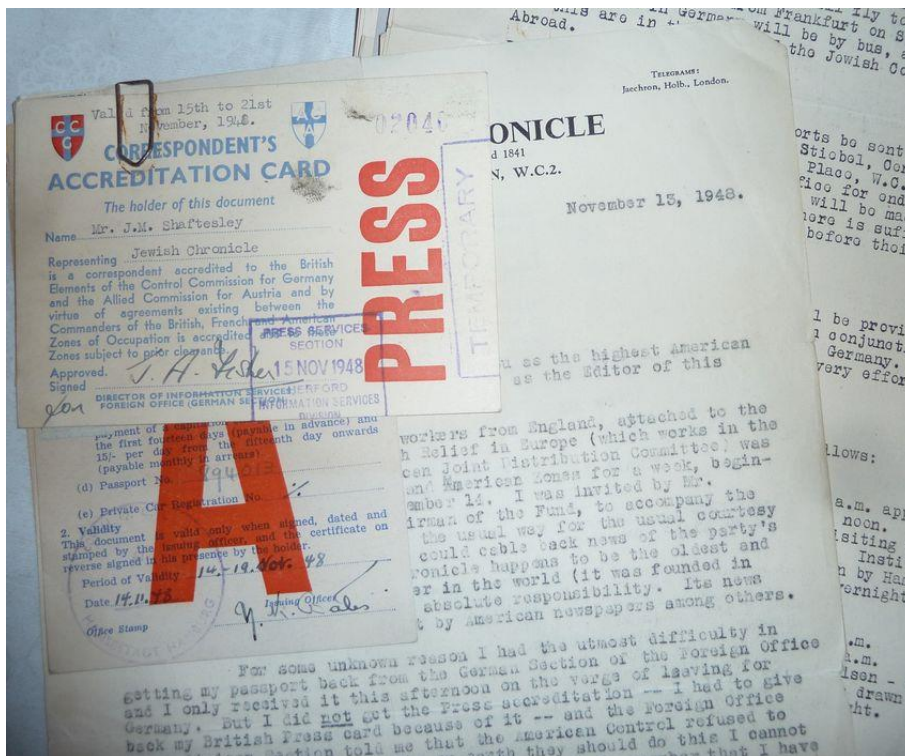

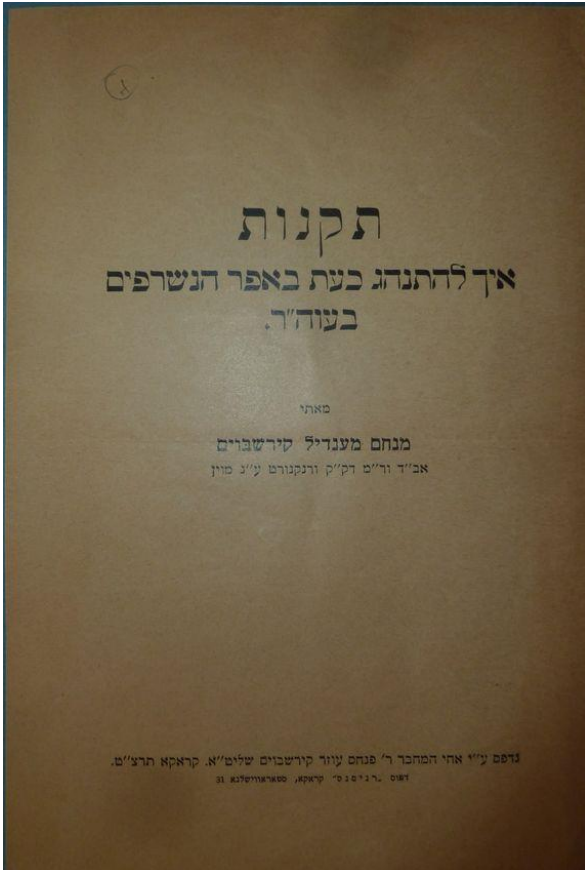

Israel Kaplan, the editor (1902 - 2003) was one of the originators of the systematic collecting of testimonies about the Holocaust and the documentation of the grim folklore of the Jews in ghettos and camps. As early as August 1941, with the sealing off of the ghetto in Kaunas (Kovno), Kaplan undertook the assignment to surreptitiously record the goings - on in the ghetto.

Directly following the liberation, he began recording the testimonies of survivors and the collecting of documentation of the Holocaust. Together with M.Y. Feigenbaum, he was among the founders of the "Tsentraler Historisher Komisyse" [Central Historical Commission] that operated in conjunction with the "Central Committee of the Liberated Jews in the American Zone" of postwar Germany. Kaplan served as historiographer for the committee. He edited this journal, "Fun Letztn Khurbm" that represented the first gathering of Holocaust material from diverse places, which summed these up in an academic manner. *[most of this information is from Ghetto House Fighters Archive]*

In the early years of Nazi rule in Germany, the Gestapo would on occasion return to loved ones the cremated remains of family members who had been summarily arrested and then murdered in concentration camps. The Gestapo sardonically forced the bereaved families to pay the financial costs for the duration the

murdered individual was “housed and fed” before death and only then would they return the body. (It was of course impossible to know whether the ashes were indeed those of the specific family member or not).

Throughout history, Orthodox Judaism has taken a very negative view of cremation and is loath to accord honours to the deceased should the remains have been cremated. This stance was by necessity challenged, due to the shocking circumstances surrounding the forced cremation of Jews by the Nazis. In the present pamphlet, Chief Rabbi Kirschbaum ruled that given the circumstances, the German Burial Societies are to place the cremated remains into a coffin together with a talith and tachrichin (shrouds) as if the body were fully intact, in order to affirm the traditional Jewish belief in the Resurrection of the Dead. In paragraph 3, Kirschbaum invoked a letter by R. Markus Horovitz of Frankfurt (author Responsa Mateh Levi) “to our Kehillah,” dated 22nd June 1893, expressing leniency toward those unwillingly cremated. R. Kirschbaum reasoned therefore, that such leniency is certainly called for in the present horrific circumstances.

See Y. Rubinstein, *Tziyun LeMenachem* (1965) for a biography and appreciation of Rabbi Kirschbaum’s writings. According to Rubinstein, since Hebrew printing was no longer permitted by the Nazis, the pamphlet was published by the author’s brother in Cracow (Poland) with the intention to subsequently distribute it in Germany itself.
