

The West End Chancel Choir is a nationally recognized choral ensemble that leads worship at the church's 11 AM service and presents concerts throughout the year. Their concerts have been recognized by the Nashville Scene for their excellence. Walter Bitner of the Nashville Symphony called the Chancel Choir's 2014 performance of the Brahms Requiem, "a deeply moving performance." The Chancel Choir has made nine tours to Europe as part of the church's ministry since 1986. They have sung at conventions of the American Guild of Organists, the American Choral Director's Association, and the Fellowship of United Methodist Musicians. Recent concerts have included performances of Bach's Christmas Oratorio, (part 1) Beethoven's Mass in C, Lauridsen's Lux Aeterna, and Tchaikovsky's Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom.
